Junior Division – Allen Bragg

I am assited by Anita Madea (Shelton School Nurse) and my wife Kathy Bragg

The junior division encompasses our club members, members of Shelton High School Rifle Team, and members of NJROTC from Shelton High School. There is no charge for the actiities of the Junior Division. The equipment needed is provided by MCSA.

Shelton High School competes in the North West Evergreen High School Rifle League. This league consists of 5 teams: Shelton, Tumwater, Black Hills (Olympia), Centralia, and WF West (Chehalis). They hold their matches at Shelton, Capitol City, or Centralia. Matches are usually held on Mondays @ 4 PM. They compete with .22 caliber rifles in 3 position matches (prone, offhand/standing, and kneeling) Results will be in the next newsletter. (Season is not quite finished).

NJROTC matches are held at various locataions around the state. They compete with air rifles at 10 meters. They compete either with precision rifles or sporter rifles. On Feb. 21st they compete in a match at Prairie High School (Vancouver). We sent a precision team, who finished 5th overall. Individuals were Marissa N., 5th overall with a score of 555/600. Blake H. 25th ovrall with a score of 492/600. He was at 50%. Austin L. with a score of 456/600. Anthhony F.with a score of 449/600.

The junior division will continue with practices through the end of May. They will be working on the Winchester 3 position Rifle program to earn their medals. The medals are Marksman, Marksman 1st, Sharpshooter, Sharpshooter Bars 1 thru 9, Expert and Distinguished Expert.

Their will be an awards ceremony for the juniors during our regular club meeting in May7, 2014.

Adult Smallbore Rifle – Allen Bragg

This is offered to adult members who wish to impove their skills in the same 3 positions as the junior division. They are elgible to earn the same Winchester medals. The fee is \$6 per night. Equipment is provided by MCSA or you can bring your own.

This discipline will continue in June after the junior division is takes a break for June, July and August.

You will need 50 rounds of standard velocity 22 per night. Time is 6:00 Pm to 9:00 PM.
