These reports can be found in the meeting room at the range, on top of the large gray safe. If we happen to be out of incident or injury reports, you can also find one of each report in your copy of the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's). Accident/Incident procedures can be found on pg. 20, an Injury Report on pg. 30 and an Incident/Event Report on pg. 32. Once you've filled the appropriate report out, you can either present it to or notify a board member / trustee within 24 hours of the event.
