“Merry Christmas To All and To All Good Shooting!”



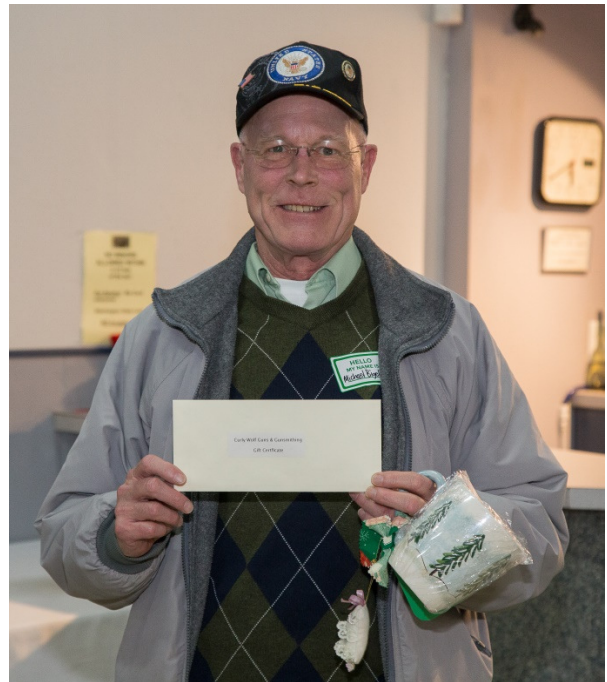

In 2017 we had four (4) firearm raffles, including a Springfield XD-9 pistol, Just Right 9 mm carbine, M&P PC Shield 9 mm pistol and another Just Right 9 mm carbine.

The four 2017 raffles resulted in 3,553 tickets sold for a NET profit of \$5,490.90. In 2016 we had five (5) raffles and a net profit of \$6,150.

For each raffle, we have had between 12 and 20 MCSA member "distributors". Alex Lev, Matt Crane, Jim Harris, Renegade Guns (Troy) and Huntington Glass (Joshua/Leslie) have been large sellers during 2017. Several members earned their years' worth of working hours. I'm still eager to add more volunteer "distributors".

Our goal in 2018 is to exceed the net profits of 2016, raffle off more popular firearms and have fun doing so.
